

**RESOLUTION**

Commissioner Sievek offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:


WHEREAS, 1987 Regular Session Laws, Chapter 27, amends Minnesota State Statute 340A.404, Subdivision 5, and authorizes the Board of Commissioners to adopt an ordinance enabling establishments who hold both an On-Sale Wine License and On-Sale Non-Intoxicating Malt Liquor License to sell intoxicating malt liquor at on-sale without an additional license, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with M.S.A. 375.51, a Public Hearing was held on May 10, 1988 regarding adoption of said ordinance.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Commissioners of Crow Wing County, Minnesota, approves an ordinance enabling a holder of an On-Sale Wine License and On-Sale Non-Intoxicating Malt Liquor License and whose gross receipts are at least 60 percent attributable to the sale of food, to sell intoxicating malt liquor at on-sale without an additional license.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this Ordinance is to become effective upon publication and approval by the County Attorney.

Which resolution being seconded by Commissioner Schmitt was duly adopted, all members voted "AYE", except Commissioner Ferrari who abstained.


