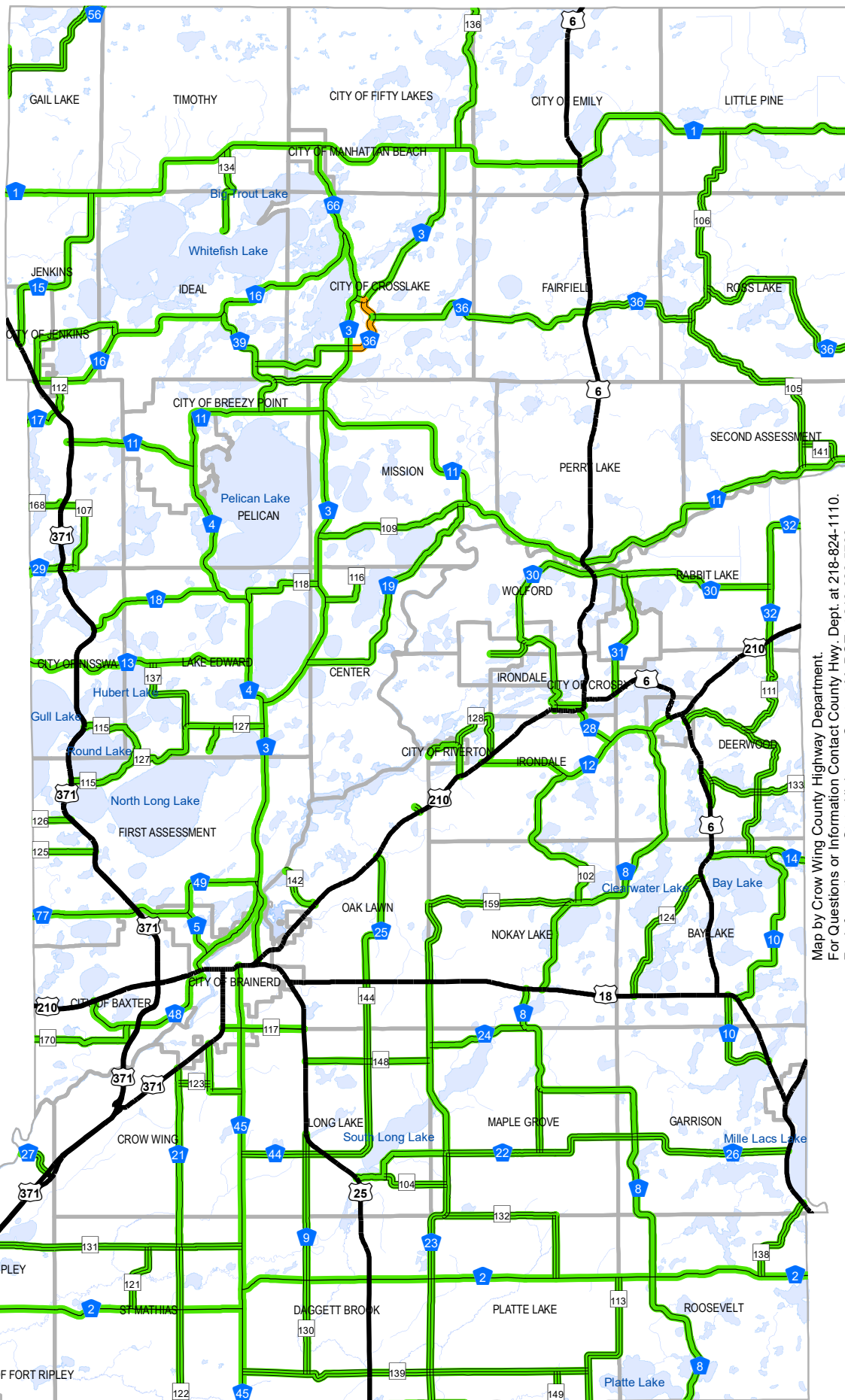

Forecast

2" of snow forecasted to start falling at 9:00 P.M. 1-6-19 and continue until 9:00 A.M. 1-7-19.

20-30 mph winds forecasted to accompany the snowfall and continue after the event is complete.

Pre Plan

Start plowing at 3:00 A.M. 1-7-19 and apply 300 lbs. of salt on centerlines.

Comments

Trucks had trouble staying on the road, even with tire chains

Increased salt from 300 lbs. to 450 lbs. because the salt was honeycombing the ice and not melting it away.

Conditions

1/4" of ice on all roads and continued rainfall into the morning.

Rainfall on top of ice made it extremely slippery

CWC Sheriff's Department issued a no travel advisory 1-7-19.
