



60-Day Waiver Request

Statute 15.99 Subd. 2 requires that “an agency must approve or deny within 60 days a written request relating to zoning, septic systems, watershed district review, soil and water conservation district review, or expansion of the metropolitan urban service area for a permit.” The County may extend the 60 day period with written notice to the applicant and stated reasons. The applicant may also request an extension of the time limit.
