**The issue statements were reviewed. A concern for fish habitat was added.**



**Tad broke us into three groups. Maps were provided on wildlife, phosphorous sensitivity, DWSMAs, Forest Habitat, Biodiversity Significance, Outstanding Resources, SFIA lands, Tribal Lands, water quality, and altered watercourses. The issue statements were passed around to each group. The group prioritized the issue statements summarized by Moriya as High, Medium, or “As Funding/ Opportunities Become Available” (for Lower Priorities) for each planning region (North, Middle, and South).**
