

Specific Service Sign Compliance Requirements

- (1) Conform with all applicable laws and regulations concerning the provisions for public accommodations without regard to race, religion, sex, or national origin.
- (2) Agree to sign format, design, and location that are determined by County Highway Department, in compliance with all pertinent state signing standards, and to make payment in advance when needed for repairs or replacement costs.
- (3) Agree to pay for all current costs required to repair the sign panel and/or sign structure resulting from damage, vandalism, natural deterioration, and other such occurrences beyond the control of County Highway Department.
- (4) Additional guide (trailblazing) signing from the county road intersection to the business will be the responsibility of the applicant and the local road authority, as mandated by Minnesota Statute 160.293, and must be in place prior to installation of county road signing.
- (5) All signing is installed on a first come, first served basis. If two businesses apply at the same time, year-round businesses have priority over seasonal businesses.
- (6) Inappropriate business names are not permitted to be displayed on sign panels.
- (7) In the event that the sign needs to be removed, applicant may obtain the salvaged sign panel within 30 days of removal, on condition that the sign shall not be reinstalled on any public right of way, nor shall it be reinstalled in any location to be visible to any motor vehicle on the County Highway Road System.
- (8) Accept the terms and conditions of the regulations of the County Engineer and agree to fully comply herewith to the satisfaction of the County Highway Department. The County Highway Department may remove the sign(s) for any failure to comply with these terms and/or non-payment or any repair or replacement costs.
