

Details/Comments

Wet snow fell and began to stick to the roads around noon to the north and to the south early afternoon. Temps hovered around 33.

Conditions

33 degrees, wet snow, additional 2" of snow compared to forecast, and 20 mph winds.

Summary

Wet snow packed with traffic. The snow rate and the amount of snow was more than could melt. 2" of additional snow fell to the north than what was forecasted. Bare wheel path goals not met on Cr 1 & 36.

Decisions Made

Called snowplows in late morning in the north and early afternoon in the south to deal with snow starting to stick to the roads. Pretreatment anti-ice worked where applied but diluted with the continued snowfall

Lessons Learned

A higher rate of salt should have been applied right away. This type of event and road temps should have melted off easily. The wind blowing the snow, causing it to stick along with the additional 2" of snow to the north impeded us from reaching our goals on some roads.
