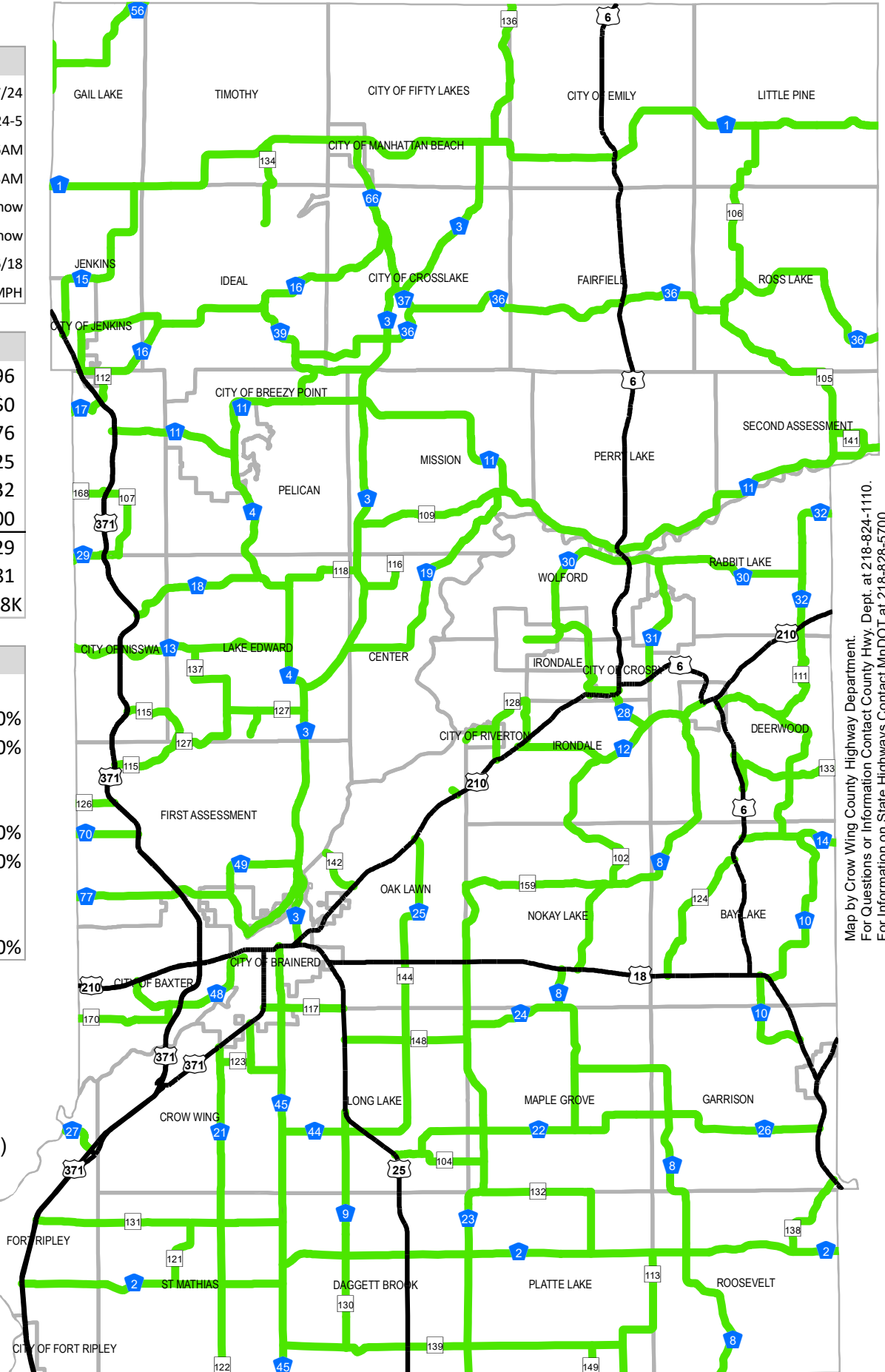

## Forecast

Light rain starting at 9:00 a.m. 1/5/24, then changing over to snow at 5:00 p.m. and continuing until 10:00 a.m. 1-6-24. Temps in the mid 30s with light east winds.

## Pre Plan

Have snowplows patrol once the rain starts, apply 150 lbs. of salt on centerlines. Come in at 6:00 a.m. on 1/6/23 to plow and continue into the evening. Apply 300 lbs. on centerline.

**Event ended** 1/7/24 3:00AM

### Details/Comments

Rain started earlier than forecasted and continued until throughout the day on 1/5/24. Snow began to fall late 1/5/24 and continued until 1/7/24 at 3:00 a.m. temps were in the upper 20s and wind was light.
