Minnesota State Statutes require that all PLS corners that are part of any land survey used in the determination of the boundaries of parcels must be certified and recorded. PLS corner records that are placed of record are commonly referred to as CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER. This form is being used to monitor compliance because Minnesota Statutes 160.15 Subd. 4. and 381.12 Subd. 3. (e) provides that; No later than one year after perpetuating or restoring the section corner, the land surveyor shall file or record the certificate in a manner as required in Statute. None compliance to this agreement after the one year period shall constitute a violation of the licensed land surveyors obligation and responsibility which could bring about legal consequences. Completion of this form does not constitute any implied approval or indication of compliance with applicable statues or ordinances.
