

OUTSIDE EVENTS

Alcohol can only be served and consumed inside the building or on an attached deck or patio that is described as the premises on the On-Sale and Sunday liquor license application. Some exceptions can be made for one-time temporary extensions of the premises for outside events on a case by case basis.

For an exception to be considered, you must have either a current Caterer's License or a Certificate of Liquor Liability covering the temporary extension of the premises.

If you have a current Caterer's License and the outside event complies with MN Statute 340A.404 Subd. 12 (a-g), then the Caterer's License would cover the temporary extension of the premises. You are responsible for notifying the Sheriff's Department of the event date.

If you do not have a current Caterer's License or the outside event does not comply with MN Statute 340A.404 Subd. 12 (a-g), then you must contact your liquor liability insurance company and obtain a Certificate of Liquor Liability which must include the date and a description of the temporary extension of the premises. The certificate must be received in our office no later than three working days prior to the event. Our office will notify the Sheriff's Department of the event date.

All approved one-time temporary extensions of the premises must be a compact and contiguous area attached to the building, totally fenced with controlled access.
